

What's New in eSafe Version 6

Introduction

The main focus of eSafe v6 is to enhance and stabilize the functionality of email features within eSafe and to add user/group policies for email attachments. Some other highly demanded features are added as well, according to requests received from customers.

New features

This release of eSafe includes the following new features:

New Feature	Description & Benefit
Email	
Email copy	Option to send a copy of all emails received for a predefined email address or domain name to another email address. Useful for archiving and forensics purposes.
Email redirect	Option to redirect all emails received for a predefined email address or domain to another email address. Useful for redirecting emails of left employees or in case of a domain name change.
User/Group email profiles	Ability to define different email profiles for users/groups from LDAP/AD for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Allowed / disallowed attachment types ▪ Email size ▪ Anti-spam ▪ Content Filters ▪ File anti-spoofing ▪ Anti-phishing ▪ Password protected archives
Spam Quarantine report localization	Allow full customization of the Spam Quarantine report from eConsole GUI, including actions and submit button.
Validate email recipients	Using integration with LDAP/AD, eSafe will be able to refuse immediately emails sent to non-existent users. This feature will greatly reduce the number of emails processed by eSafe as well as eliminate the redundant non-delivery (NDR) emails that are being sent to the sender. Note: Usage of this feature significantly minimizes the load on the eSafe MTA and will dramatically improve performance and reliability.

New Feature	Description & Benefit
Spam quarantine report email aliases	Administrators will be able to define methods for treating email aliases from LDAP/AD in order to eliminate multiple reports to users with several email addresses.
Outlook 2007 Quarantine Report	Outlook 2007 does not support forms in email. A new report email format will still enable user self-management of the spam quarantine directly from the report email.
Report Message-ID	The MAIL-ID (internal) and the Message-ID (external) are now written into the report and the session.log for all emails.
Web	
File-type blocking policies	Ability to define policies for users/groups with file types (file extensions) allowed to be accessed / downloaded
Support URL filter in HTTPS	URL Filter will also work for HTTPS websites
Blocking Un-recognized sites	Ability to block Un-recognized sites that are not categorized by the URL Filter
Miscellaneous	
Backup before Hotfix	Keep a backup of updated files during autoupdate/hotfix to enable rollback in case of problems
Log update version in report	Successful updates will be logged in the report along with the update version
Report email size	Write the size of the email in the session.log file. This will allow generation of various statistical reports on email sizes.
Spam exclusions for spam keywords	The email addresses defined in spam exclusion list will not be checked for spam keywords as well.
Localization support in LDAP	eSafe LDAP module now supports localized entries based on Unicode encoding.
Users identification in Citrix	Option to correctly identify different users working on the same Citrix server and apply correct URL Filter policies for each one of them.
Windows Vista eConsole Support	eConsole full support for the Windows Vista operating system. Note: Just eConsole! eSafe cannot be installed on Windows Vista.
ICAP user identification	Ability to identify users/groups that are sent by the ICAP client (a proxy) to eSafe during ICAP session.
AppliFilter support in ICAP mode	Support AppliFilter also in ICAP mode. Please note that this will be only partial support. Only protocols tunneled through HTTP will be inspected (since proxy only works on HTTP protocol).
